*Cannot count towards more than half of the required number of service hours.

Service hours will not count when doing “chores” at your place of residence. Service hours must be completed outside of your place of residence without pay. Example: babysitting your brother does not count. Babysitting a cousin without pay does count. **CHORES DO NOT COUNT AS SERVICE HOURS.** Diversity of experiences in performing community service is encouraged. *In order to qualify for induction into the Blessed Mother Teresa Society, one must perform a diversity of service.
