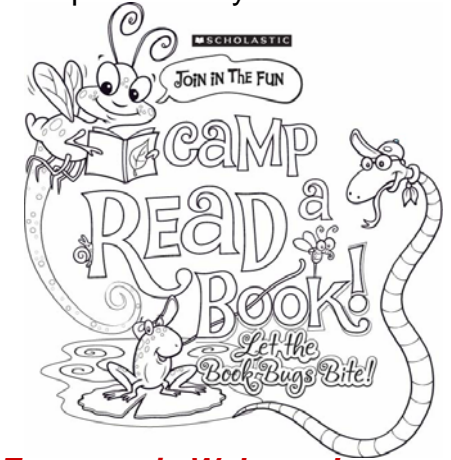

### Summer Extended Day Program

A reminder that the program will begin on Monday, 5 June, starting at 6:30 a.m. The drop-off and pick-up area the first two weeks of the summer will be the hallway by the 4th grade classrooms. Next week, paperwork will come home to explain what students can bring and wear and what they will need.

A few families have requested limited time enrollment. In order to simplify the process, we will accommodate this by allowing for families to register and pay for a minimum of 30 days (out of 50). At the start of the summer, families will be asked to fill out a calendar to declare the days they will send their children to the program. This will be used to staff the program. Payments can be made weekly. If parents need additional days, we ask for as much advance notice as possible.
