



## Help Find a Cure!

Dalton Brooks, a third grader here at St. Luke was diagnosed with Juvenile (Type I) Diabetes in the Spring of 2000 at the age of 2 ½ years. People acquire this disease when their bodies suffer an autoimmune attack which destroys the insulin-producing cells in the pancreas and prevents them from ever being able to make their own insulin again. Insulin is the hormone that allows the body to metabolize sugars and is required for living.

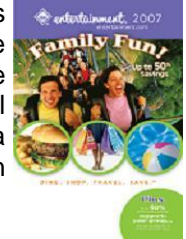
To live through this, Dalton has to give himself multiple insulin injections (4-6 daily) and constantly monitor his blood sugar by pricking his fingers for blood (8-10 times daily) throughout the day and night. He strives for the elusive balance between his insulin dosages, types and amount of food eaten and physical activity level. Diabetes is the leading cause of kidney failure, adult blindness, and non-traumatic amputations. Dalton will never grow out of Juvenile Diabetes. His only way out is a cure. A cure is within reach with continued adequate funding for research such as that done by the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation.

To that end, Dalton has participated in the Walk to Cure Diabetes. Last year, Dalton set a goal of \$2,000 and reached it through the help of friends and family. This year, Dalton has set a goal of \$5,000. Normally, the school cannot guarantee support of requests to assist those in the community who want to use the Light as a means of individual communication, but we have made it a goal to help students in Middle School find meaningful ways to serve the community, and to help families find ways to perform service as a group. This is one of those chances. Dalton is hosting a team to participate in the Walk for a Cure Event on Saturday, 14 October at 9 a.m. at Milam Park. The family needs names of participants by this Friday, 29 September in order to have t-shirts for all
