Each year, thousands of patients die from leukemia and other life-threatening blood diseases due to a lack of a bone marrow donor match. Registering for the National Marrow Donor Program is as easy as filling out a form, giving a cheek cell swab, and a willingness to donate to any patient. Attention 8th Grade Families

In accordance with an Archdiocesan policy change which was put in place earlier this month, Catholic grade schools will be required to provide to Catholic High Schools (along with the student's other final records) a standard form which requests the following certifications for entering 9th graders:

- The student has had no suspendable offense during the 2nd semester,
- The student has completed the 8th grade and is eligible to enter the 9th grade,
- The student is clear of all financial obligations to the grade school.

The Catholic High Schools will provide the grade schools with a list of students that are enrolling at the specified high school.

SAT-10 Testing

SAT-10 testing started Monday, 26 March 2007 and will continue through Tuesday, 10 April for some grades. Please be sure to avoid all absences and tardies. **We will not be able to call into classrooms for early dismissals or admit late students to class during testing periods.** If you have any questions regarding your child's testing schedule, please contact your child's homeroom teacher.
