



Field Day Approaches


Field Day, Friday, 18 May, is one of those special end-of-the-year events that is held for the children of the school. It is a fun day for all, students, teachers, and parents. **We are again in need of many, many parent volunteers** to supervise the games, to chaperone the third class grouping in grades 1-8, and to help the PE Department with set-up and clean-up. The time will be from 8:45-12:15. Coach Fuentes has a sign-up sheet in the gym, outside the gym office door, for parents to sign up; parents can also phone the gym office at ex. 120. The events are: *basketball, Crackle ball, water balloon volleyball, kickball, obstacle course, 3-legged & Soccer Ball relay races, football/Frisbee throw, potato sack & golf ball/spoon relay races, CYO concession stand, GYM concession stand, bucket brigade, tricycle races, mission impossible, tug-o-war, water balloon toss, and flag football.* Each volunteer will be given specific instructions on how to run that particular event. Last year's event was very successful, so we are trying to build on this. We are planning a meeting for all volunteers on Wednesday, 16 May, at 5:00 p.m. in the gym, as a way to plan and make sure all details are arranged.

- * Waterballoons. *For this we need volunteers to fill the balloons with water Friday morning 7:30 a.m.-9:00 a.m. in the gym concession and outside the gym near the batting cage. There will be approximately 400 balloons.*
- * Rolling ice chests to carry the balloons
