- Cost is \$100 per player, payable with registration. Make checks payable to “St. Luke Knights of Columbus”. Includes 18 holes of golf, box lunch, cart fee, assorted “goodies” and prizes.
- Proceeds go to St. Luke Catholic School Parish Scholarship Fund and other worthy ministries.
- Men play from the Gold tees, women from the Silver (white) tees.
- Putting contest: Entry fee \$10. 3 putts from 25 feet. Must make at least one putt to qualify. If no one makes a 25-footer, three closest contestants to the hole will “putt off” from 15 feet until someone wins.

- **Mulligans: Limit 3 per player, \$5 each.**
- **Closest to the flag:**
 - **Men: Hole #5 and #16**
 - **Women: Hole #7 and #13**
- **Longest drive in fairway:**
 - **Men: Hole #10**
 - **Women: Hole #14**
- **Hole In One Contest: to be determined.**

DIRECTONS TO THE COURSE:

From Highway 281 exit Bitters Rd and head west on Bitters. Proceed 2.5 miles to SilverHorn Drive and turn left. Follow the signs to the clubhouse.

From Anderson Loop 1604 exit Bitters Rd and head east on Bitters. Proceed approximately 4 miles to SilverHorn Drive and turn right. Follow the signs to the clubhouse.

From IH-10 West exit Huebner Rd and head east on Huebner 4.6 miles to Bitters Rd and turn right. Proceed 1.9 miles to SilverHorn Drive and turn right. Follow the signs to the clubhouse.

From IH-10 East exit DeZavala Rd, head east on DeZavala 2.7 miles to NW Military Hwy, and turn right. Go south on NW Military 0.8 miles to Huebner Rd and turn left. Proceed 1.7 miles to Bitters Rd and turn right. Proceed 1.9 miles to SilverHorn Drive and turn right. Follow the signs to the clubhouse.

- **From IH-410 exit Blanco Rd and head north on Blanco. Proceed 4.1 miles to Bitters Rd and turn right. Proceed 0.7 miles to SilverHorn Drive and turn right. Follow the signs to the clubhouse.**

Hole Sponsorship

A sign bearing the name and contact information, as well as a logo or advertising slogan, of your business will be posted on the tee box of one (or more) of the 18 holes on the golf course.

Cost: Hole sponsorship alone- **\$150**

Hole sponsorship plus participation in the tournament by a four-player team of employees, customers, or anyone else chosen by the sponsor: **\$500** (\$50 discount.)

Contest Sponsorship

Sponsors may associate their business name with one or more of the following contests taking place during the event:

- Long Drive: Men, 10th hole; Women, 14th hole.
- Closest to the Flag: Men: Hole #5 and #16; Women: Hole #7 and #13
- Putting Contest: on the practice green throughout the event.

Contest sponsors will have a sign posted on the appropriate tee box or next to the putting green as outlined above. Sponsors may either pay \$150 cash for each sponsorship or donate prize items of approximately \$150 in value (actual cost, subject to approval by the Event Committee). As with the hole sponsorships, each sponsor may enter a team of four players per sponsorship at a total cost of \$500 if paying cash, or \$350 if donating prize items.
