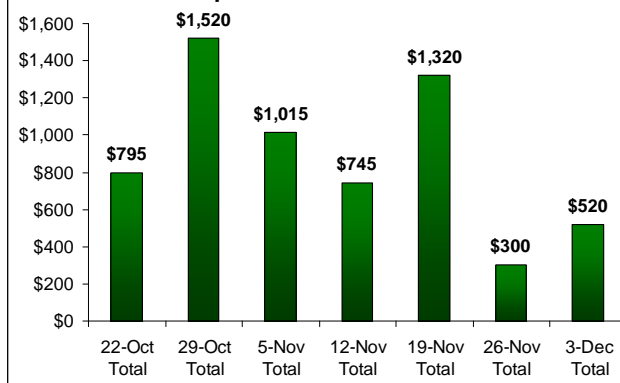
Congratulations on Perfect Attendance
