Tuition for the 2008-2009

Tuition coupons for the 2008-2009 school year will be mailed on Friday, May 2. Tuition for a family (in-parish or out-of-parish tuition rate) was calculated using verification of parishioner status from the parish office. Included with your tuition coupons is information on automatic deduction of tuition from your bank account. If you already have automatic payments you still need to fill out the information as the tuition amounts will change for the new school year. If you do not receive your tuition coupons by mid next week, contact the school office immediately.

Any changes to your tuition payment plan must be made by Thursday, 15 May
