<i>Objective 1: Students will demonstrate the role of faith in their lives as Catholics.</i>		
<b>Action Steps</b>	<b>Person Responsible</b>	<b>Timeline/Evaluation</b>
1. Explore new ways to encourage greater participation in the choir and singing at Mass.	Classroom Teachers and Music Teacher	Spring 2013; open to more grade levels; on-going
2. Schedule periodic collections at school masses to donate to parish service projects.	Teachers and Beta Club	Spring 2016
3. Continue to schedule service projects providing the Beta Club and Catholic Student Club with the opportunity to be of service to the elderly, children in St. Peter St. Joseph Children's Home (St. PJ's), the Brigidine Sisters, the homeless, etc.	Teachers and Beta Club	Fall 2014; on-going
4. During classroom religious instruction, students will explore how the lives of Catholic Saints contributed to society.	Religion Teachers (all grades)	Fall 2014; on-going
5. Students will include scripture readings during the morning prayer once a week.	Religion Teachers (all grades)	Fall 2015; on-going
6. Students will practice appropriate worship participation in a variety of religious events (i.e. Living Rosary, Stations of the Cross, Mass).	All Teachers	Fall 2013; on-going



*Objective 2: Students, Parents, and Community will explore ways to practice their faith with greater meaning.*

<b>Action Steps</b>	<b>Person Responsible</b>	<b>Timeline/Evaluation</b>
1. Each academic year, coordinate one presentation in the classroom by a Priest or other religious representative on a religious topic appropriate for that age group including religious vocations.	Religion Teachers	Fall 2013; on-going
2. Arrange with the Faith Formation office, or other representative, the presentation of a lesson for the students explaining the components of the liturgy.	Religion Coordinator	Fall 2013; annual activity
3. Arrange with the Faith Formation office, or other representative, the presentation of a lesson for the teachers explaining the components of the liturgy and paraliturgies.	Religion Coordinator	Fall 2015
4. Investigate ways to encourage greater participation of the St. Luke students and families at the Catholic Schools Week mass in January of each year.	Teachers and Administration	Fall 2013; on-going
5. Organize an all parent-led school Mass.	PTC, School Council, and Administration	Fall 2014; annual event during Catholic Schools Week
